Digital Literacy Curriculum and Artificial Intelligence

- CT State Department of Education (CSDE) to develop Model Digital Citizenship curriculum in collaboration with Commission (Section 145 of [Public Act 24-151](#))
- Serves as a baseline for AI education pilot program (Section 143 of [PA 24-151](#)) to take place by June 30, 2025 (2024 – 25 school year)
- Alignment with Digital Equity curriculum, part of Wave-1 Capacity Grant
- Ongoing collaboration planned between Commission and CSDE

Data Privacy Exemption Report

- Supports district reporting requirement on use of software as part of IEP or 504 plans, defined in [Public Act 18-125](#)
- Longitudinal data sets (2018 – 2024) available for public review at data.ct.gov, including District Exemption Use by Year and Exemptions by District
- Considerations regarding future need for data collection and reporting
